VoteCal, the Statewide Database is UNRELIABLE.

That unreliability is one major reason that Photo Voter ID should be a top priority throughout the election process

Example of VoteCal's unreliability

VoteCal recorded almost

124,000 more votes than voters
recorded as voting in the Nov. 3,
2020 Presidential Election

Another Example of VoteCal's Unreliability

A review of the official list of voters and number of votes cast in the California **Nov. 8, 2022 Election** reveals

43,624 more votes and over 22,000 more voters than the numbers certified by the CA Secretary of State.

This calls into question the validity of the certification of the 2022 election.

- Faulty and bloated voter rolls
- Mass mailing of ballots
- Unlimited ballot harvesting

Enables impersonation

Required Photo Voter ID will end possibilities of voter impersonation

"Absentee ballots remain the largest source of potential voter fraud."

Consider:

80.76% of Californians cast

Vote by Mail ballots in 2024 election

In the November 8, 2022 Election

- 21,355 voters had two or three votes
 credited to their respective Registration

 ID numbers
- If these multi-votes are removed, there were still 22,210 more voters listed than the number of votes certified.

Effective Voter ID/ ID Laws

- Only Gov. Issued Photo IDs
- Affidavits NOT Acceptable

•ID Laws:

- Must have consequences
- Must assist vulnerable populations obtain acceptable ID without cost
- * Proof of U.S. Citizenship to register

An effective Voter ID Law

Must have Consequences

 Must include provisions to assist vulnerable populations to obtain their Voter Photo ID at no cost to voter.

The U.S. Supreme Court Upholds Voter ID laws*

"They are in the state's interest to prevent voter fraud."

"They do NOT violate the 'normal burdens' of voting"

2008 Crawford v. Marion County Election BD.

Photo Voter ID Does NOT Suppress the vote

Or negatively affect voter turnout

Allegations of voter suppression due to required voter ID have been definitively debunked.

Recent Gallop Polls Show:

84% of Americans across all political, racial and socio-economic groups strongly support all voters showing photo ID at the polls
